

WANDERING PERFORMER GUIDELINES
OREGON COUNTRY FAIR
July 9, 10, 11, 2010

Wandering Performer Guidelines have been created to assist path performers at the Oregon Country Fair with positive experiences and develop an awareness of their role within a greater community. As performance space is at a premium, it is important that each performer be flexible, creative and cooperative when choosing their path space and sound levels and consider the larger community of performers, stages, attendees, and booths.

PERFORMER GUIDELINES

1. Do not set up or start a show that competes for the audience of other path and stage performers.
2. Be respectful of space and sound levels.
3. Rotate performance spaces by wandering throughout the 'Fair.
4. Help your audience keep paths open for foot traffic.
5. Connect with booth members before setting up in front of a booth.
6. Cooperate with the 'Fair and Entertainment staff.
7. Solicit donations with discretion and respect.
8. Battery-powered amplifiers and recorded music are prohibited.
9. Performers not following these guidelines may be escorted from the 'Fair.

The Oregon Country Fair is a drug and alcohol free event.
Glass containers, alcohol, illegal drugs, video cameras and dogs
are not permitted on 'Fair property.
