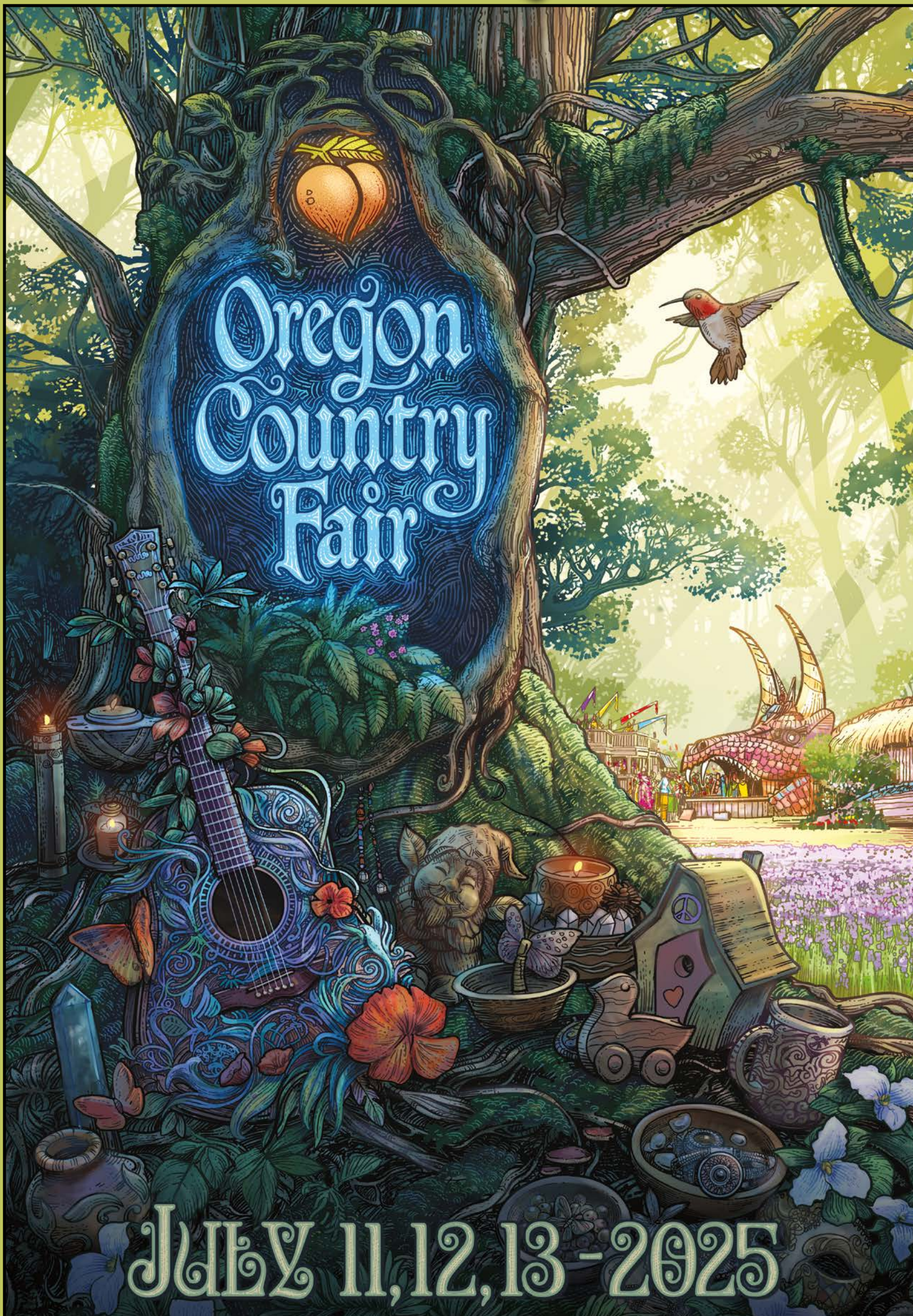

Keeping Green

To demonstrate our commitment to making an event built on sustainability and care for our planet, the Fair has identified reducing our carbon footprint as an important area where we can have an impact. Fair staff and volunteers are engaging in understanding our current carbon impacts to identify areas where we can make significant improvements. Reducing individual automobile trips to the Fair is one of the most obvious and clear ways to reduce carbon emissions. Thank you to everyone who bicycled, carpooled or took the bus to the Fair!

Recycling

We are dedicated to minimizing the impact we have on our land and planet. Our success depends upon you! All the food service ware, including beverage cups, are compostable or reusable!

- Place disposable service ware & beverage cups in the green compost receptacles.
- Utensils go into the utensil buckets at each collection kiosk.

Tickets

Tickets are available at aftontickets.com/OCF2025 NO tickets are available on the Fair site.

- **Early Bird pricing, through June 15th:** \$50 for Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- **Full price after June 15th:** \$60 for Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- **Children 12 and under are admitted free.**
- **Seniors (65 and over) and alter-abled tickets are \$5 off.**

Shuttle Bus Service [K2]

Ride the bus! You don't need a bus ticket; your Fair pass gets you on any LTD bus for free. That includes fast and frequent shuttle service from Valley River Center and the downtown LTD station. **The LAST BUS LEAVES THE FAIR SITE AT 7:30!** LTD schedules are available at ltd.org or by calling (541) 687-5555.

Bag Checks [B4 & L4]

We have two options for storing your items while at the Fair:

- **Dragon Plaza:** Look for the "Check It" sign in the SW corner of the plaza.
- **Main Stage Meadow:** Visit the WOW Hall Bag Check.

Medical & Crisis Response [D5 & L3]

White Bird Rock Medicine is still your emergency response 24/7 at the Fair. For the second year, we are operating as a stand-alone nonprofit supporting other local nonprofits serving the community. We dispatch trained medical and mental health professionals to incidents anywhere on site, embracing a harm reduction approach to compassionate care. All services are free and confidential.

Each of our two locations has doctors available 24/7 throughout the event. Find us instead of calling 911, we are the fastest response!

How to find us:

- **Visit our two locations:**
Big Bird next to Main Stage Meadow [B5], and **Little Wing** in Xavanadu near Wind Gate [L3].
- Find any Fair staff person carrying a radio.
- **Call us via the Fair's internal telephone system,** located at most stages, gates and info booths.

Basic First Aid supplies are also available at all info booths. A.E.D.'s are distributed throughout the event site (see the map pg 14-15).

Access Advocates for the Alter Abled (4A) [K4 & E5]

We promote equal access for all Fair participants with equipment loans, sign language interpreters and other assistance including advocacy, education and advice. 4A is located in the Dragon's Head at the entrance and also in Community Village.

Child Care [B4 & H2 & K5]

The Child Care Crew is dedicated to bringing the magic of the Fair to the youngest among us!

- **Sesame Street Child Care:** Checked-in, supervised childcare for potty-trained, willing kids with a wide range of stimulating and enriching activities and entertainment. The Child Care Crew also offers alter-abled and special needs care. Please ask our friendly desk staff for more information!
- **Wally's Way Family Fun Zone:** Family-friendly entertainment, an enchanted castle playground, free library, and hands-on crafting, learning and imaginative play. New this year, we're thrilled to welcome Wally's Way Arc Lane's Sensory Zone, a welcoming, inclusive space for all. Whether you're feeling overwhelmed or just need a moment to recharge, this calm environment offers relaxing activities, sensory tools and a peaceful atmosphere to help you pause, reset and return to the Fair when you're ready.
- **Mellow Spaces:** Semi-supervised shady areas on Sesame Street, Wally's Way and on Moon Path in Xavanadu, where families with small children can relax and recharge.

Cloth Diaper Service [F4]

Earth Baby Cloth Diaper Service is here for you in Energy Park! Diapers can be rented and returned during Fair hours through 5:00 on Sunday. Cloth diapers are available for \$15/dozen with a \$30 refundable deposit. Plastic storage bags and pins are available, but please supply your own covers. No more crappy disposables to deal with!

Live Demonstrations of Energy Efficiency & Nature Positive Lifestyles

- **The Straw Builders** are an association of various experts and interested parties who come together to further the practice of straw building. They promote and conduct research and testing in order to share knowledge with working professionals and the public at large.
- As Eugene's oldest recycling nonprofit, **BRING** has a wealth of information, practical tips and programs to help you live well without waste. Reusing materials is a simple yet effective way to reduce your environmental impact and create beautiful, unique spaces.

Interactive Demonstrations

Experience fun, interactive physics demonstrations featuring the air, water and the sun, including:

- **The Solar Showers.** See and feel how the sun heats water in collectors on top of the Center Booth.
- **Cell Phone Charging.** Observe how battery charging systems work via solar panels.

Returning to Energy Park

- **The Earth Cloth Baby Diaper Service** has a mission to provide, "Cloth diapers for your baby's comfort while enjoying family time at Oregon Country Fair - no more crappy disposables."
- **Bring your seeds!** The Seed Booth will bring a larger quantity of collected and donated seeds, set up an exchange with the goal to share free seeds with the community, and educate on the importance of seeds. By empowering individuals to save and share seeds, we contribute to food security and environmental stewardship.

Welcome to the LGBTQIA+ affinity space! We believe culture change comes from our collective voices letting those in power know what we need to be safe and cared for. We have an adult space, a teen space, an LGBTQIA+ library, a Gender Affirming Photobooth and Queer Living Room. Please come lend your voice!

We acknowledge this space is on the ancestral and unceded territory of the Kalapuya. We honor indigenous two-spirit beings and will not tolerate appropriation of two-spirit identities. We honor that LGBTQIA+ BIPOC are impacted by violence and oppression disproportionately, and we will center these voices when present.

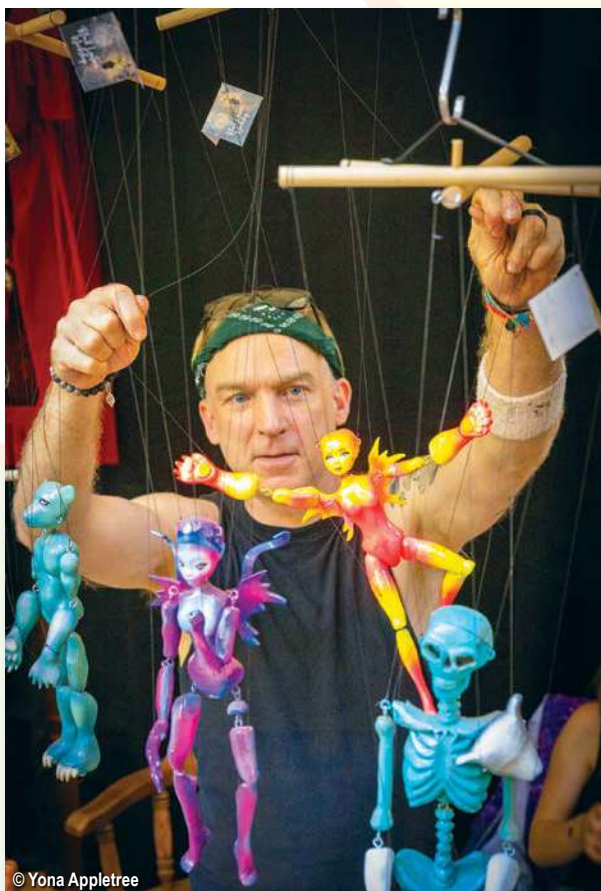

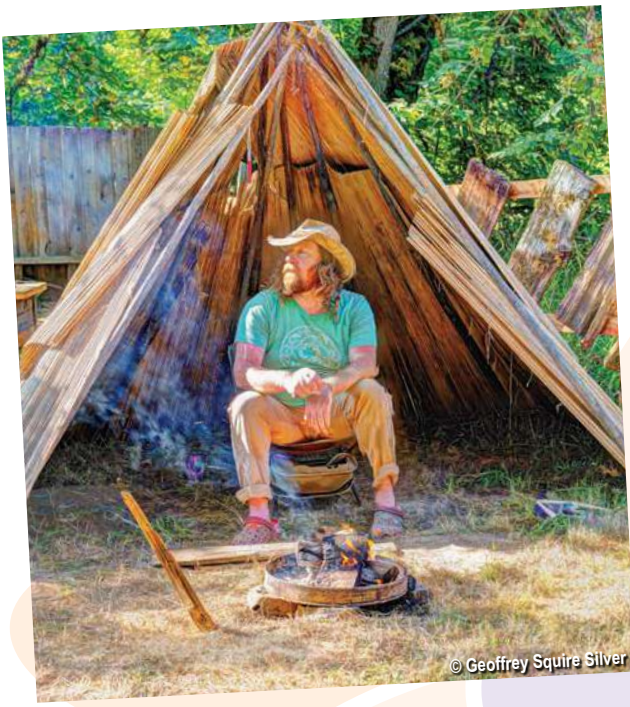

Fair Philanthropy

The Fair has been rooted in philanthropy since it began as a fundraiser for a children's program. Our philanthropy is focused on building community and helping people thrive.

We have three grantmaking programs that together have donated more than \$1.5 million: The Bill Wooten Endowment Fund, the Jill Heiman Vision Fund and Board of Directors donations. To learn more, wander over to Wally's Way to visit the Galleria Philanthropia booth or visit oregoncountryfair.org.

Jill Heiman Vision Fund

Five nonprofit groups with proposals related to the environment and sustainability will receive grants from the donations made to the Jill Heiman Vision Fund at this year's Fair:

- **The Civil Liberties Defense Center** will increase its trainings, which empower local environmental activists and organizations to take on issues such as climate change, risky oil and gas pipelines, and logging of old-growth forests.
- **Community Supported Shelters** will install two greywater filtration systems that provide an environmental approach to wastewater in their Safe Spot Communities. This completes the water filtration project that began in 2023.
- **Plaza Nuestra Comunidad** will help pay for a Garden and Community Engagement Coordinator to facilitate educational and community-building events.
- **Shift Community Cycles**, which refurbishes used bicycles, will provide free Bike Kits that include a lock, helmet and lights for bike recipients in need.
- **Siuslaw Watershed Council** will purchase native plants that will be given to household landowners along riverways and lakes to plant along their watershed, which will help protect water quality.

Look for donation boxes at Information Booths around the Fair. Food vouchers, cash or checks may be donated. Checks and cash donations are tax-deductible; please include address for mailed receipt. **The OCF Board will triple the power of your gift by matching every \$1 donated with \$2, up to a total of \$25,000.**

Bill Wooten Endowment Fund

The Bill Wooten Endowment Fund awarded a total of \$20,000 to support nonprofit organizations serving youth in the Fair's neighboring communities in the Fern Ridge area. The grants tangibly represent the Fair's deep appreciation of our home community.

Archaeology Park [B8]

Step back in time along the banks of the Long Tom River with Ark Park's educational, research and preservation of the Fair's rich archaeological heritage. Our buildings of hand-split cedar were built with traditional construction methods. Ark Park hosts demonstrations on traditional skills including flint knapping, fire making, hide tanning and basketry. Learn about the Kalapuya people, their history and the world they lived in then and today, including how the Kalapuya managed their landscape and harvested its bounty. Visit with our archaeologist at the Ark Park museum to learn about the U of O archaeological studies during the 1980s that found over 10,500 years of cultural history and saved the Fair. Peruse replicated items and instructional books produced by our demonstrators for sale at the Trade Booth. Join our workshops or just stop by and learn something new about some very old skills.

• **Culture Jam:** Fern Ridge area youth received scholarships to attend this eight-day arts-based empowerment camp for teenagers held each summer at the Fair site.

• **Elmira Elementary School:** Beats in Motion will involve students in drumming fitness (increasing heart rate, keeping time/rhythm, and choral drumming) and in learning about drumming styles from different cultures. Students will showcase their work at an "Informance" for parents, peers, friends and the community.

• **Lane Arts Council:** For a reading/arts collaboration project with the Fern Ridge Public Library consisting of free workshops that will engage students in creative learning, connect families to the summer reading program, deepen participants' understanding of creative storytelling, and provide high quality arts experiences.

• **SMART – Start Making A Reader Today:** Community volunteers will be trained and supported to help students at Elmira and Veneta Elementary Schools develop a love of reading, with book topics representing diverse identities.

• **Veneta Elementary School:** Students will participate in From Mud to Vessel, learning clay-joining techniques and developing a foundation for understanding structural integrity and architecture. Each student will create a functional pottery vessel and help develop a collaborative art piece.

Leslie Scott Imagine Grant Award

The annual Leslie Scott Imagine Grant Award is recognition given to the endowment-funded project that best represents former Fair General Manager Leslie Scott's contributions to the Fair, which has included providing opportunities for youth, reaching out to our neighbors, and nurturing creativity. This year's awardee is Lane Arts Council.
